Admissions FAQs

Are all students screened for New Hope? What if they had good grades at their old school?

New Hope Christian Academy has a rigorous curriculum that includes Project Based Learning, Experiential Learning, and critical thinking skills, among other pedagogy. In order to help determine student ability that leads to success, all applicants are screened for admission regardless of previous school, or recommendations. Students in grades 1 - 5 must submit records secured by New Hope from the previous school before further assessment is considered.

What kinds of questions are on the assessment?

New Hope uses a variety of assessment tools to help determine critical thinking and academic ability level including evaluative tools designed by the school. All assessment instruments are to depict an overall picture of each child's academic, critical thinking, and social emotional level for the grade they are applying for.

Does my child have to be toilet trained to enter your school?

Although 3 year old students may not be toilet trained at their initial assessment, and pull-ups may be necessary, all PK students and above must be toilet trained and able to use the bathroom independently.

How much does it cost?

Full cost of tuition at New Hope is \$11,000 per year. However, families may apply for a sliding scale tuition rate that is based on their income.
